All applications will be held in the strictest confidence, only the Financial Aid Committee (FAC) of San Diego United Futbol Club will review the information. No information will be provided to any individual or entity other than the FAC of San Diego United Futbol Club.

No "full" scholarships will be awarded.

When applying for financial aid there is a \$150.00 non-refundable deposit fee due at the time of Registration. Availability of any financial aid is also dependent upon the amount of money in the Club's financial aid fund.

SAN DIEGO UNITED VOLUNTEER SERVICE PROGRAM

The Volunteer Service Program offsets San Diego United Futbol Club's Registration Fees based on individual needs and level of participation in Volunteer Service. These volunteer service hours are above and beyond what other full paying families normally provide in the way of fundraising for the team. After your application is reviewed, you may be awarded an amount by the committee in the range of 25% to 50% based on information provided to us from the application, prior history with the club in regards to player attendance, commitment, past payment history and parent volunteering if you were given FA in the past. Your volunteer hours will be decided when your amount is awarded. Typical Assistance and Volunteer hours are as follows:

- 50% *10 Volunteer Service Hours**
- 35% * 8 Volunteer Service Hours**
- 25% * 6 Volunteer Service Hours**

*Team Account fees include team entry fees to various tournaments as determined by the team’s coach and the Director of Coaching, coaches’ travel costs, and miscellaneous team expenses as approved by the Board of Directors.

reimbursement

Financial aid assistance **cannot be used towards Team Account under any circumstances.

Consequences: When communication is lacking between parent/player and the coach/manager that results in the player missing training or any team event, **3 verbal warnings** will be given to the parent/player with notification to the Directors of Coaching for that age group. If the lack of parent/player communication continues after the 3rd verbal warning the **player will be benched**. This consequence will hold true for those behind on registration payments. The Board of Directors, Director of Coaching and Coach will review the situation. Outcome will be based on a case by case basis. A minimum fine of **\$25.00** will be charged to reactivate the players card
